## What Does Furnace Maintenance Get Me?

### Your home furnace maintenance includes:

- ✓ Check and adjust thermostat levels.
- ✓ Check for all safety controls and wire connections.
- ✓ Perform a visual inspection of the heat exchanger.
- ✓ Check and clean the thermocouple or flame sensor.
- ✓ Check, clean the igniter, spark electrode and pilot.
- ✓ Check and replace filters.
- ✓ Adjust dampers for heating/cooling mode.
- ✓ Cleaning and inspection of all of the burners and the burner compartment.
- ✓ Remove and clean the blower, test run the capacitor for performance benchmarks.
- ✓ Check and flush the condensate drains or traps.
- ✓ Inspect the venting system for leaks, debris, or anything else out of the ordinary.
- ✓ Check for the required service access.
- ✓ Check for adequate combustion air requirements.
- ✓ Lubricate all moving parts.
- ✓ Cycle the furnace and monitor the ignition and flame for issues.
- ✓ Check and record manifold pressure/clock input.
- ✓ Check temperature rise and adjust blower speed as required.
- ✓ Perform CO test and record the readings.
- ✓ Test the fuel line for leaks at the appliance.
- ✓ Check presence of gas pipe pressure test tag.
- ✓ Check for manufacturer's installation and operation manuals.
- ✓ Wipe down and clean the area surrounding the furnace.
- ✓ Compare utility costs and equipment life expectancy with the homeowner.
- ✓ Offer replacement batteries for the smoke detector.
- ✓ Check for a CO alarm.
- ✓ Review and document results and recommendations with the client.

## 5 Furnace Myths - **Busted!**

### **Myth**

Close your vents and registers to save money.

### **Fact**

You're actually wasting money by doing this. It makes sense: If a room is unused, there's no sense in having the vent or registers open. Hot air pressure is distributed evenly through your home. When vents or registers are closed, your furnace has to work harder to deliver heat.

### **Myth**

All you need is a high-efficiency furnace.

### **Fact**

It helps, but there's more you can do. A high-efficiency furnace will lower your heating bill, but that's not the only way to save money. A modern furnace, combined with proper insulation, clean air ducts and ongoing maintenance keeps more money in your pocket.

### **Myth**

Don't buy new. Just keep fixing your old furnace.

### **Fact**

Just like an automobile, your home's furnace has a lifespan. A furnace runs for hundreds of hours each winter, and age and wear-and-tear will eventually take its toll on it. Metal and system fatigue will simply be too much to overcome. Also, a furnace that's too old isn't necessarily the safest and the situation could possibly lead to carbon monoxide poisoning.

### **Myth**

A larger heating system is better for your home.

### **Fact**

A system that's too big for your home actually does more harm than good. If a heating system is bigger than normal, it should heat up a home quickly and efficiently, right? A system that's too big will run very inefficiently. Not only might that be uncomfortable, it will also lead to exceptionally high energy bills.

### **Myth**

Crank the thermostat to heat your home ASAP.

### **Fact**

Hot air gets delivered at the same rate, regardless of temperature. Whether you turn up the thermostat by 1° C or 10° C, warm air gets delivered through your home at a consistent rate.
